



## City of Geneva Facilities COVID-19 Response

1. Understanding the threat of COVID-19 and why we are taking this seriously
  - Review printed materials provided
2. City Hall
  - High risk employees will be handled accordingly based on individual circumstances
  - They are not required to report to work if they choose not to
  - As of now, City Hall remains open. HOWEVER, foot traffic into the building is highly discouraged. The following will be posted on the front door of City Hall:  
*During this time, please make any payments for utility billing or Parks & Rec in the drop box or over the phone. Please contact City Hall by phone to make other arrangements. We will be flexible. PLEASE DO NOT use the drop box for payment if you are sick and/or showing symptoms of COVID-19.*
  - If you have questions or concerns, please contact City Hall at 402-759-3109 during normal business hours. We will keep you informed as things change throughout this event.
3. Geneva Senior Center
  - Will remain closed through (tentatively) **March 30**
  - Situation will be reassessed closer to that date
  - Home-delivered meal program continues
4. Parks & Recreation
  - Suspending all events through (tentatively) **March 30**
  - Situation will be reassessed closer to that date
  - Rec Center is closed indefinitely
5. Theater
  - Suspending all events through (tentatively) **April 30**
6. Library
  - Facility, meetings & uses will close at **6 PM on March 17 through (tentatively) March 30**
  - There will be one-day availability of curbside service on March 18 from 10 AM – 6 PM. Call 402-759-3416 or text 402-264-6914 for assistance
  - Library closure/opening will follow Fillmore Central Public Schools
7. City Parks
  - Remain open for the time being but highly discourage use & large gatherings
