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**Social Distancing**

Urge Chamber of Commerce, FCDC, Lions Club, all civic & community events, churches to cancel or reschedule events that attract people from outside of Geneva

Institute remote meeting protocol for any official city government meeting or event

Non-perishable food, water, and medical supply drive, if there is no need for the food, all food will be donated to Blue Valley

All City government sponsored public meetings, including planning and zoning, are canceled until further notice with the exception of the Geneva City Council regular meeting which will take place remotely

Require posting COVID-19 advisory on all public locations that host public events, including Lions Clubs, churches, and parks

Discourage travel outside of Fillmore County & Geneva & limit travel in city limits via social media

Residents are urged to only travel for essential business. Call ahead for appointments

Heavily urge Chamber of Commerce, FCDC, Lions Club, and churches to cancel all events for foreseeable future

Establish a command center at City Hall with appropriate social distancing protocol

In case of hospital overload, establish FCH Behavioral Health Wing, Fillmore County Fairgrounds, motel's in City limits, Library basement, Lions Club, Downtown Gym, and other locations if needed as triage and isolation centers
